

Invitation To Tender For An Anti Bullying System For Leicester City Schools

Leicester City Council wishes to invite suitably qualified suppliers to tender for a contract to provide an anti-bullying system on behalf of the Council's Children and Young People's Services department. The system must meet the following requirements:

- The system must be accessible by children, parents and carers, and create an environment where even the shyest child feels able to come forward and inform the school that they are being bullied. Any system must embrace technologies that will allow children to do this, such as e-mail, and potentially have the capability to accept and respond to text messages.
- The system must be able to collect and collate statistical data from over 100 schools and children's homes, and then enable Council officers to produce quantitative data showing them where they have bullying incidents, and thus allow them to target their resources in a more effective way.
